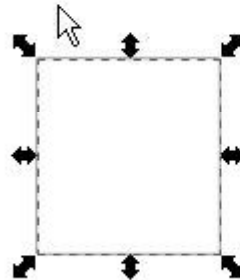
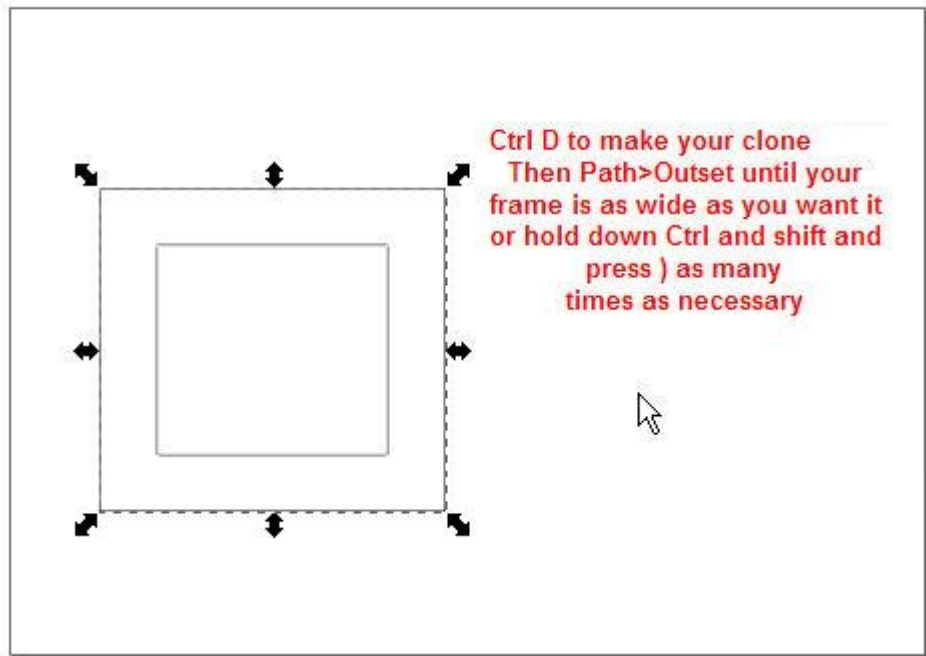
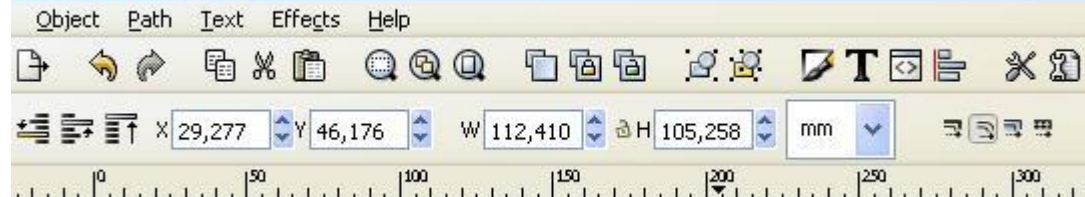
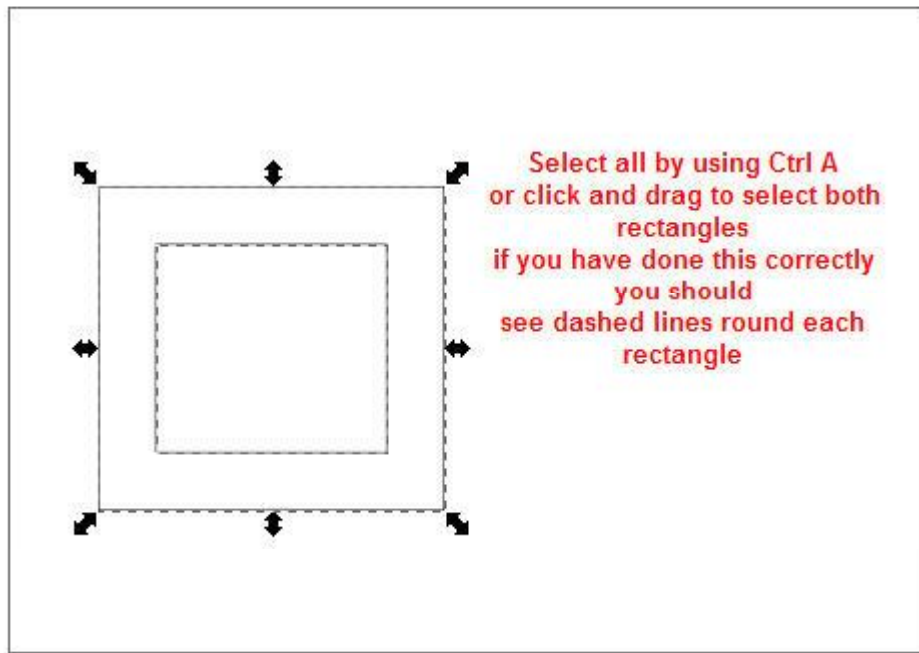
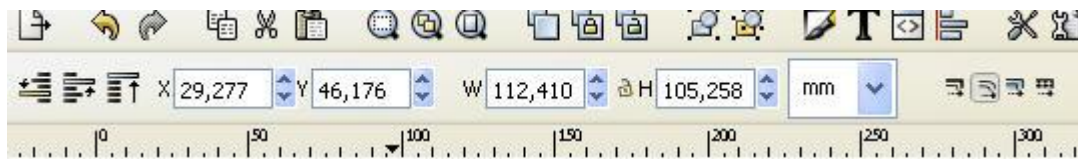


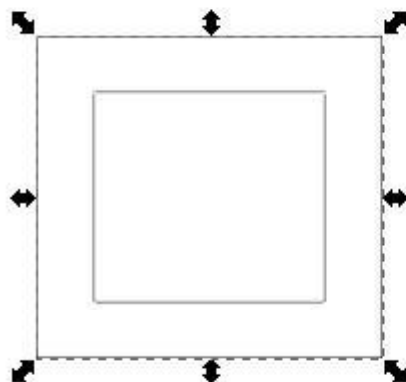
Making a frame and welding
a letter or number to it



Open a new page in Inkscape
View>Display mode>outline
Draw a rectangle
using the rectangle tool







Now do Path>Exclusion
the dashed line round the
inner
rectangle disappears and
you now have a frame which
behaves as a single element.
Unless you do this step
correctly you
will not be able to weld your
letter or image
and the inner rectangle will
disappear!



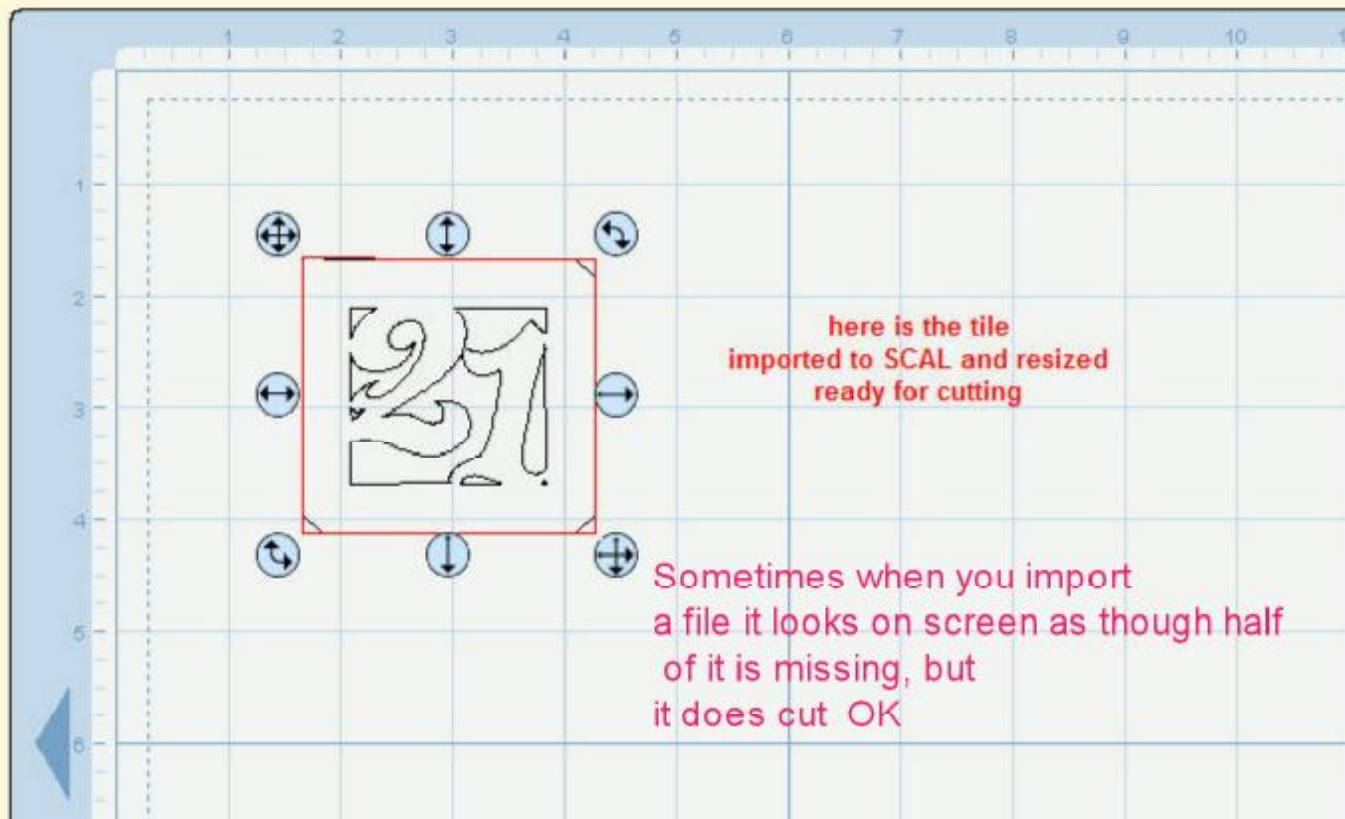
Type your letters or numbers
separately and move over the
frame
so they are touching

Font = Black Rose



Select all
Path>Object to Path
Path>Union

the finished tile is ready to be
saved as .svg



here is the tile
imported to SCAL and resized
ready for cutting

Sometimes when you import
a file it looks on screen as though half
of it is missing, but
it does cut OK



Make a simple number card:

1. Type your number
2. Ctrl D to clone it
3. Flip it
4. Move the flipped number to the left using the arrow keys on the keyboard
5. add a rectangle for the base
6. Select all Path>Object to Path Path>Union
7. Save as .svg
